





FOREWORD BY RACHEL COLE OPERATIONS DIRECTOR FOR FOSTERTALK

I am both proud and saddened to be sharing this report with you. Firstly proud because at FosterTalk our mission is to help create better outcomes from families and young people, and so we've created this report in what we hope will be a guide to those young people considering or about to embark on the chapter of their lives and venture off to university, foster carers providing support to those young people, and also the universities themselves.

However, by creating this guide, it has highlighted the challenges, obstacles and issues that still need to be tackled to help facilitate better outcomes for young people who have been in care. Currently, when a young person reaches the age of 18, unless there are extenuating circumstances, they leave the stability and care of a foster home, and this in itself can be a daunting situation, as the stories we have shared in this report from those with lived experiences, highlights.

We also hope this guide will help facilitate conversations and collaborations around how we can collectively work together as a fostering community to help achieve greater equity and equality for young care leavers. Often those who went into care in the first instance, faced some element of trauma, isolation or rejection, and we know from listening to these young people, that leaving care requires support and preparation. Going to university throws up a whole new set of challenges in itself, which can amplify the obstacles to be overcome.

In pulling together the research for this guide, I would like to say thank you to all the universities that contributed with information about their support services for care leavers. While the types of support is varied and wide ranging, it has also highlighted the breadth and lack of standardisation of support provided by universities. More about this can be read in the summary of the research provided on page xx. I hope that universities will find this comparison useful and provide some food for thought on other areas they may adopt, if they do not already do so.

To all those young people about to go to university, I wish the very best of luck. To those carers who have supported them to get to this point, thank you for everything you have done. And to the universities, please remember they are still young people and help support, guide and safeguard them, as they venture out into the big wide world





MARCUS PHOENIX SHARES HIS STORY AS A CARE LEAVER GOING TO UNIVERSITY

University can be a major step for any young person, but for care leavers, it can be filled with extra trepidation as Marcus Pheonix, a second year student at Teeside University and care leaver explains.

Here's his story:

I had been in and out of care as a child and had never really settled anywhere. I was born in Yemen and moved to the UK when I was 11 but things weren't great at home with my father and I carry a lot of traumatic memories and experiences.

So when I started at university, I didn't have a parental role model to help guide me. There wasn't someone who had been to university and could help me prepare with both the practical and emotional side of things. But because I had lived on my own for a few years before becoming a student, I knew how to take care of myself. I saved as much money as I could beforehand, just to be able to afford some of the basics like bedding, cooking utensils, things to help make by bedroom feel a little more homely, as well as consider the cost of Freshers Week. It's a big time in the social calendar for a new student, and obviously I wanted to be able to get out and meet people, go to events and nights out, and be part of everything, not segregated because of financial constraints.

I do get some enhanced support from the university with things like being able to stay in my student accommodation all year round. That first break at Christmas, when everyone was leaving to go home to their families, was really hard to take.

Which is why the biggest support I urge universities to look at providing is counselling. I've had to pay for private counselling which I've really needed to help me deal with many of the challenges university life has thrown at me. I don't have a family support network so when I've faced bullying and gossip because other students see me as different, I originally turned to other student support groups. But I've found that this approach can actually make things worse and I've needed another avenue to go down for help; someone outside of the student and university world.

Having good mental health is so important. If it's not right, then you can't focus on your studies, you can easily become isolated and not want to socialise, and you feel less motivated to get a job.

I've had to get a part time job to help fund the private counselling I have needed. However, I do receive some brilliant support from the team at EPIC Futures, which is a programme set up to help young people aspiring to be an entrepreneur to set up their own business. I started Candy Castle, a 3D animation company, through the scheme, and alongside my studies, I'm trying to make money through the skills I have, to help support my studies and even one day, have the essence of a business I can make bigger and better after I graduate. But starting a business is hard work while you're trying to do other things, and so the part-time job has been needed to fill the gap. While other students may get top-ups to their student loans from family, I have to be completely self-sufficient, in all aspects of student life.

We have seen great strides in recent years in terms of support available to care experienced students. However, there is still a long journey ahead. Supporting and encouraging young people to pursue their goals and career aspirations is absolutely essential to contributing to their self-esteem, sense of identity and can help teach them a whole new range of life and independent living skills.

From undertaking this research three key issues stood out:

If support is offered, it needs to be continuous

Many students commented that while during the initial stages of joining university they received great support, after the settling in period, this seemed to fade and cause issues such as demotivation and lack of direction.

Accommodation is key

Giving students access to a safe and warm space throughout the entire year is invaluable to young people as many worry about where they will be able to stay during the holidays. Having a space to call their own and know they can always go back to, is of great importance since they may have not always felt this sense of security.

Build communities

While it is fantastic to have a range of support packages available, creating a sense of community would also have a big impact. Enabling the students to have opportunities to connect with one another and build bonds rather than only reporting to those who are in a position of authority to them, can help break down barriers and allow them to feel comfortable in their new environments.

Unite Foundation



UNITE FOUNDATION FOSTER TALK UNIVERSITY GUIDE

The Unite Foundation delivers a unique university accommodation scholarship for care leavers and estranged students across the UK. The scholarship takes care of students' accommodation and bills, covering up to 3 full years of study.

We provide scholarships for around 80 new students across the country each year and we currently work with 26 universities across England and Scotland. Recent research showed the impact of our scholarships on student progression and outcomes, with Unite Foundation students achieving a 'good degree' (2.1 or 1st) within 3 per centage points of non-care leavers.

Alongside the scholarship we also run the This is Us Community, a dedicated and safe online space for all estranged and care experienced students. This is Us Community is not limited to those on the scholarship, we encourage all care experienced and estranged students in UK Higher Education to join and connect with their peers. SUMMARY OF UNIVERSITY SUPPORT PROVIDED TO CARE LEAVERS

The following table provides a summary of the support provided by universities to care leavers. Whilst we appreciate this is not the full and extensive list of all universities, at the time of producing this report, this is either the information our research team could find via the universities' own websites or was provided to us in a Freedom of Information request.

University of Bath



- Dedicated team to give advice and guidance to care leavers.
- Flexible admissions offers can be made after considerations.
- Applicant travel bursaries are available to attend interviews or visit days.
- £1000 bursary available per year of study as well as a £1000 start-up cost and £1000 graduation bursary.
- · Care leavers are eligible for University's Bath bursary or Gold scholarship.
- 365 day accommodation available throughout duration of course.
- Named contact who can offer support and guidance on a number of transitional issues and conducts check-ins throughout the year.
- First year peer mentor available.
- NNECL members.

At Bath, we're passionate about supporting students to succeed, particularly those who may face more challenges on their journey to and through university. We've therefore, long been a strong supporter of students who have experienced being in care before entering the University.

We have a dedicated team in Student Services, which provides a stable and supportive focus for support, advice, and signposting and our students highly value this support, including the additional funds provided by the supplementary bursary for students leaving care. For students applying to start studying at Bath in 2023, subject to terms and criteria, the University will also guarantee a conditional offer, typically at 1 grade below the standard offer if they complete one of Bath's outreach programmes: Pathway to Bath, Discover Bath, Target Bath or Access to Bath.

Graduating student Amber, who collaborated with our outreach team to develop new Student Experience webpages, says of her journey:

"I was so excited, but a bit daunted to move to Bath, and the Student Services team has been alongside me the whole way, giving me time that's just about me, and a point of contact to pick up the phone to anytime, as well as loads of practical help."

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Bath Spa University



- Be Inspired! Outreach programme provides pre-entry information for care-experienced students.
- Member of the NNECL.
- Part of the SWLAC.
- Provided with an advisor on acceptance on an offer who supports with the transition to university and
 works alongside the care leaver's local authority or independent fostering agency to discuss and sort
 finances, accommodation, transport and additional needs.
- · Guaranteed year-round accommodation.
- · Opportunity for individually assessed extra bursaries.

University of Birmingham



- Care Leavers who are eligible can access the Chamberlain Award of £5975 if moving into university halls or a cash bursary of £3000.
- Scholarship of £2000 per academic year as well as £500 graduation bursary is provided.
- Two scholarships are available but are funded annually dependent on donations.
- Single point of contact is given for advice on entering higher education.
- · Outreach programmes are in place for younger students.
- Pathways to Birmingham allows eligible students alternate offers two grades below standard offer.
- UCAS applicants (not on pathways) are still eligible for contextual offers one grade below standard
- Applicants who are self-identified are contacted during application process and those who require interviews receive interview support.
- Bespoke welcome event for care leavers.
- Accommodation deposit waiver is available without having to pay a bond.
- Care leavers get their first-choice university owned halls, and these can be for 365 days a year if needed.
- Welcome packs including bedding, utensils and a meal voucher is also given.
- Those commuting receive a booklet for advice and information too.
- Employment support and bursaries available as well as study abroad opportunities .
- Members of the NNECL and the West Midlands Care Leavers Network.

Bishop Grosseteste University



- Uses links with Barnardo's for outreach services.
- · Members of the NNECL.
- Committed to offering year-round accommodation and have a guarantor scheme for care leavers.
- Students also receive welcome package including some household essentials.
- Offers a free counselling service and a 24/7 telephone service hosted by Endsleigh's Wellbeing service.
- Enhanced bursary available and is non-repayable.
- · Introduced the leaving care scholarship. Financial aid is also given to support graduation.
- Students have assistance looking for part-time work during study.

University of Bradford



- Dedicated outreach support for care leavers, named contact and peer mentoring available.
- Contextual offers can be made for admissions for nearly all degree programmes.
- Year-round accommodation can be given.
- A Care Experienced Students' Grant offers £1000 as well as additional financial funds can be accessed.
- Step Up to HE programme to meet peers.

University of Brighton

The support provided is part of a research study to help create a programme future care leavers can use too.

The students involved will have access to the University of Roehampton support services and live on campus for free for two weeks before they start university. They do not have to be enrolled to start at University of Roehampton. To take part, the prospective student must be over the age of 18, have accepted an offer from a London based university (not only Uni of Roehampton), and have experienced care within the UK before the age of 18.

The developed programme looks to examine areas like mental health support, physical well-being, and academic support, for example learning how to write at an academic standard with the use of critical thinking. Those involved will have free on campus accommodation and three meals a day paid by the project for the duration. Throughout the academic year there will be monthly sessions to further the student's development and ensure they are fulfilling their potential. All activities will be paid for by the project too.
